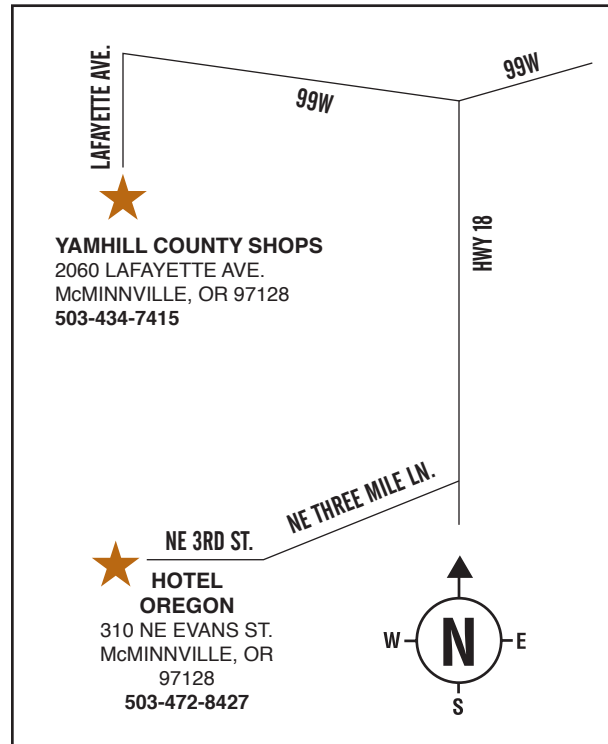
MAJOR RULES:

DIRECTIONS TO MCMENAMINS HOTEL OREGON, 310 NE EVANS ST., MCMINNVILLE, OR 97128:

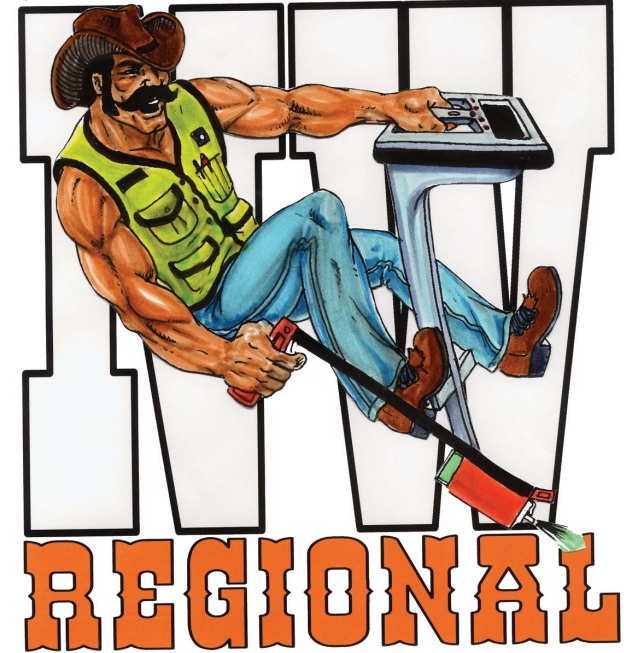
